CHILD CARE PROVISIONAL LICENSE WAIVER STATE OF MICHIGAN

The Child Care Organizations Act (PA 116) allows for the issuance of a provisional license when a licensee is temporarily unable to comply with the licensing rules or PA 116. The law includes information about the rights of licensees when a provisional license is recommended. These rights are listed in MCL <u>722.117a(3)</u>.

I understand that the department has recommended issuance of a Choose an item. provisional license. I also understand the rights afforded to me. With notice of these rights, I have decided to:

1. Accept issuance of the provisional license.

- 2. Waive my right to receive written notice of the reason for the proposed modification of my license.
- 3. Waive my right to have 30 days to appeal the proposed modification to provisional.
- 4. Waive my right to request an administrative hearing to contest the reason for the proposed modification of my license to provisional.

I understand that I must submit an acceptable written corrective action plan, and by signing and returning this form, my license will be modified to provisional status for six months. I also understand that halfway through the provisional period, I will receive a renewal packet.

I further understand that if I do not sign and return this form, I am contesting the issuance of the provisional license and am requesting written notice of the reason for the provisional. I understand contesting the issuance of a provisional license begins a disciplinary process and that I must still submit a corrective action plan.
