The meeting was called to order by Chairman Deloney at 11:02 a.m., noting that a quorum

Moved by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the above actions be taken in accordance with the E-Quote reports dated January 9, 2012, motion carried by unanimous vote.

III. Ms. Hamilton presented licensee requests for special price reductions on spirit products in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's Order of February 15, 2006 regarding special price reductions on spirit products. She advised there are 20 different licensees requesting price reductions, and that 361 price reductions should be approved, with 51 price reductions being denied for reasons stated in the attached reports.

Moved by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the special price reductions be approved as indicated on the attached Approval for Price Reduction on Liquor reports, motion carried by unanimous vote.

Moved by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the special price reductions be denied for the reasons stated in the attached Notification of Denial for Price Reduction reports, motion carried by unanimous vote.

IV. Ms. Hamilton presented a summary of the November 2011 financial statement. She stated that this report shows the results of our operations for the period October 1, 2011 through November 30, 2011, and is compared with the same period from the previous fiscal year. She reported that the Distilled Spirit cases sold, increased by 35,185 (3.0%) during the first two months of 2011-12 year; that Total Gross Sales also increased over the last year by approximately \$7.9 million (4.9%); and that Net Income from the sales of liquor is higher this year by \$1.4 million (5.1%).

Ms. Hamilton advised that the numbers on page 6 of the November 2011 monthly financial statement showing increased Beer Taxes, Wine Taxes and Mixed Spirit Drink Taxes are inaccurate as there was a mistake in the year end closing entries. She advised that as a result, the September 2011 beer/wine/mixed drink taxes are included with October and November in the new fiscal year. Therefore, the tax amounts shown on page 6 for 2011 cover three months, whereas the 2010 numbers are for two months. Ms. Hamilton advised this error will be corrected in January and this information has been shared with the Office of the Auditor General.

Ms. Hamilton reported on a major change concerning the Fire Protection Grant charges for the new fiscal year. She advised for several years, the Liquor Purchase Revolving Fund (LPRF) has been charged with \$2,410,500 of the State's total Fire Protection Grant Payments and that these payments are made to local governments for fire protection services. Ms. Hamilton stated this fiscal year the LPRF will be charged a total grant amount of \$773,900; but will also be responsible for paying Bureau of Fire Services Expenses up to \$2,636,500. She advised this funding change was made by the Legislature during the Budgeting and Appropriation process.

After a brief discussion, moved by Chairman Deloney, supported by Commissioner Quimby, to accept the financial report for November 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.

### V. Old Business

Ms. Wendt reported that HB 5087 which eliminates production limits for a brewer to sell its beer for on-premises consumption at one location of its brewery licensed premises was signed by the governor and is now Public Act 298. She advised this bill was effective on December 22, 2011.

**VI.** New Business – There was no new business to conduct.

## VII. Public Comments

Commissioner Weatherspoon requested an explanation and status of the NSF check report dated January 5, 2012. Ms. Hamilton advised that as of January 5, 2012 the Commission had an outstanding balance of NSF checks of \$160,171.97 and that the majority of this balance was checks written by nine different licensees. She reported that approximately one third of this balance has been paid. Ms. Hamilton advised that the Commission has been collecting the NSF checks fairly fast and that in December the balance of outstanding NSF checks is larger because of the holidays.

Chairman Deloney pointed out that the statute requires licensees to pay cash for alcoholic beverages and unlike other products the licensees do not have the option of waiting 10 to 30 days to pay for their product. He further stated that some licensees repeatedly wish to use the Commission as a revolving loan fund. Commissioner Quimby stated this issue is a concern because if a licensee can not control this portion of their business, how are they running the rest of the areas of the licensed business. She indicated that poor management could affect other aspects of their business. Chairman Deloney advised more research will be required to look at other options the Commission may have to address this issue.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the business meeting be adjourned at 11:18 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
