Mr. Robinson requested approval of licensee requests for special price reductions on spirit products in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's Order of February 15, 2006 regarding special price reductions on spirit products. He advised there are 40 different licensees requesting price reductions, and that 666 price reductions could be approved, with 74 price reductions being denied for the reasons stated in the attached reports.

IV. Mr. Neumann advised that Mary Fox, applicant for a new Server Training Program, was present to answer any further questions the Commission may have about her program. Chairman Deloney asked Ms. Fox if she had time to review the additional comments and suggestions made by Commissioner Weatherspoon. Ms. Fox responded that she had briefly reviewed them and had no problem in making any changes the Commission felt were necessary. Chairman Deloney advised that Commissioner Weatherspoon is very passionate about education and has presented some well thought out concerns for this process. Chairman Deloney made a motion to approved the application with the amendments, supported by Commissioner Quimby and a Roll Call vote was taken on the motion:
