The meeting was called to order by Chairman Deloney at 11:11 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

- I. Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Commission meeting of February 7, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
- II. Ms. Hamilton presented the E-Quote reports for product listings in four categories and requested approval of the following:

III. Ms. Hamilton presented licensee requests for special price reductions on spirit products in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's Order of February 15, 2006 regarding special price reductions on spirit products. She advised there are four different licensees requesting price reductions; that 145 price reductions should be approved; and that 10 price reductions should be denied for the reasons stated in the attached reports.

Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the 145 special price reductions be approved as indicated on the attached Approval for Price Reduction on Liquor reports, motion carried by unanimous vote.

Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the 10 special price reductions be denied for the reasons stated in the attached Notification of Denial for Price Reduction reports, motion carried by unanimous vote.

IV. Chairman Deloney advised that a request for a declaratory ruling was received from Attorney Michael J. Brown on November 22, 2011, on behalf of Tin Can-West Saginaw, LLC, (Tin Can), who holds Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses in Eaton County. He stated that at a meeting held on December 20, 2011, the Commission granted the request for a declaratory ruling concerning the legality of Tin Can's "10 for 10 Card" customer loyalty program and specifically whether the program violates §1025 of the Michigan Liquor Control Code of 1998, being MCL 436.2025. Chairman Deloney stated that the declaratory ruling in this matter is limited exclusively to the "10 for 10 Card" program and that the program offered by Tin Can violates the clear and unambiguous language contained in the relevant portions of MCL 436.2025 and MCL 436.2013.
