FINAL DECISION OF THE CONSTRUCTION CODE COMMISSION

On April 14, 2020, the Construction Code Commission was presented with Mr. George F. Beattie's appeal of the denial of his application for registration as a mechanical inspector and plan reviewer. The Commission acknowledged receipt of the appeal on April 14, 2021, reviewed the material provided, and considered the matter at a public meeting on that date. Mr. Beattie attending the meeting and spoke in support of his appeal. This decision is issued pursuant to Section 1021(3) of 2016 PA 407, MCL 339.6021(3).

Following discussion, a motion was made, supported, and passed to deny Mr. Beattie's appeal because he does not meet the licensure qualifications for registration as a mechanical inspector or plan reviewer under Administrative Rules 408.30043 and 408.30049(6).

THEREFORE, it is the final decision of the Construction Code Commission to deny Mr. Beattie's appeal due to not meeting the licensure requirements for registration as a mechanical inspector or plan reviewer under Administrative Rules 408.30043 and 408.30049(6). Judicial review of this decision may be pursued in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*

FINAL DECISION OF THE CONSTRUCTION CODE COMMISSION

On April 14, 2021, the Construction Code Commission was presented with the Application for Construction Code Appeal submitted by Mr. Aaron Phelps, Esq., Varnum LLP, on behalf of Tyler and Josiline Bowdish over the issuance of a building permit for the property located at 3487 66th Street in the Township of Saugatuck. The Bowdishes appealed the Township of Saugatuck Construction Board of Appeals' February 12, 2021 denial of their appeal to that Board. The Commission acknowledged receipt of the appeal on April 14, 2021, reviewed the material provided, and considered the matter at a public meeting on that date.

Mr. Phelps attended the meeting and spoke in support of the appeal. Mr. James Straub, attorney for the Township of Saugatuck, attended the meeting and spoke in support of the Township of Saugatuck Board of Appeals' decision. The application and all supplemental materials were reviewed by the Commission. This final decision is issued pursuant to Section 16 of 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1516.

Following discussion, a motion was made, supported, and passed to affirm the Township of Saugatuck Board of Appeals' February 12, 2021 decision, and therefore, deny the Bowdishes' appeal because the building permit application did not meet the requirements of the Township of Saugatuck's fire code which is an applicable law or ordinance under Section 11(1) of 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1511(1).

THEREFORE, it is the final decision of the Construction Code Commission to affirm the Township of Saugatuck Board of Appeals' February 12, 2021 decision. A judicial review of this decision may be pursued in accordance with Section 18 of 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1518.
