## FIRE OFFICER Level I & II NFPA 1021 Compliant Course

## Course Description:

The purpose of the Fire Officer I course is to provide entry-level fire officers with the knowledge and skills to meet minimum job performance requirements for paid and volunteer fire officers. Fire Officer I candidates must demonstrate the knowledge and skills necessary to function safely and effectively as an integral member of a firefighter team. When engaged in hazardous activities, the Fire Officer I works under direct supervision of a senior company officer and as a team leader.

The purpose of the Fire Officer II course is to provide officers at the second level of progression with the knowledge and skills to meet the minimum job performance requirements for paid and volunteer fire officers. Fire Officer II candidates must demonstrate the depth of knowledge and skills necessary to function under general supervision. A person trained at the Fire Officer II level will function safely and effectively as an integral member of a team of equally or less experienced firefighters to accomplish a series of tasks.

This is a combined Fire Officer I & II program and will not be separated.

This Fire Officer program provides insight into the role of the officer as defined by NFPA 1021.

**Quiz's:** One after each lesson **Written Test:** 100 questions (70% passing score)

Practical Test: Scenario Based at end of course.

When & Where: Contact course manager for Dates, Location and Time of class. Class will be traveling department to department to share the drive for all.

Must register on SMOKE (Course Offerings & Registration)

Books will be provided at no cost to students: Obtainable first day of course.

This course is funded fully with State Fireworks Funds rules and regulations apply.
