

## CHIROPRACTIC LICENSING GUIDE

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR CHIROPRACTOR LICENSE BY EXAMINATION (first license)**

- Graduate from a chiropractic educational program that is accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE).
- Pass Parts I, II, III, and IV of the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners (NBCE) examination.
- Arrange for submission of verification of licensure in any state or U.S. territory where licensed, even if the license is no longer active.
- Submit the Chiropractor by Examination Application found at [http://www.michigan.gov/lara/0,4601,7-154-72600\\_72603\\_27529\\_27531---,00.html](http://www.michigan.gov/lara/0,4601,7-154-72600_72603_27529_27531---,00.html) along with the appropriate application fee.
- A fingerprint report and criminal background check are required if not previously taken for a Michigan health care license. Fingerprints must be taken using the instructions and ID numbers that are sent to the applicant after the license application and fee are received.

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR CHIROPRACTOR LICENSE BY ENDORSEMENT (currently licensed in another state)**

- Arrange for submission of verification of licensure in any state or U.S. territory where licensed, even if the license is no longer active.
- If licensed less than five years in another state, pass Parts I, II, III, and IV of the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners (NBCE) examination.
- Submit the Chiropractor by Endorsement application found at [http://www.michigan.gov/lara/0,4601,7-154-72600\\_72603\\_27529\\_27531---,00.html](http://www.michigan.gov/lara/0,4601,7-154-72600_72603_27529_27531---,00.html) along with the appropriate application fee.
- A fingerprint report and criminal background check are required. Fingerprints must be taken using the instructions and ID numbers that are sent to the applicant after the license application and fee are received.

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR CHIROPRACTIC EDUCATIONAL LIMITED LICENSE (student)**

- Complete at least two years, four semesters, or six quarter terms in a chiropractic school that is accredited by the CCE.
- Arrange for supervision from a Michigan-licensed Chiropractor for the 6-months practice portion of the chiropractic education.
- Submit the Chiropractic Educational Limited Application found at [http://www.michigan.gov/lara/0,4601,7-154-72600\\_72603\\_27529\\_27531---,00.html](http://www.michigan.gov/lara/0,4601,7-154-72600_72603_27529_27531---,00.html) along with the appropriate application fee.
- A fingerprint report and criminal background check are required. Fingerprints must be taken using the instructions and ID numbers that are sent to the applicant after the license application and fee are received.
