

## Class B AFFF Collection Program Ending July 2020

In November 2019, US Ecology was awarded a contract from the Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy (EGLE) to collect and properly dispose of Class B Aqueous Film Forming Foam (AFFF) containing per- and polyfluoroalkyl (PFAs) from Michigan fire departments.

Please be advised, the collection program is ending on July 31, 2020. US Ecology is currently contacting the remaining fire departments that participated in the Bureau of Fire Services' Class B AFFF survey.
