## Hi Kimberly:

Happy Holidays, I hope you are doing well. I have success story for you. On November 12<sup>th</sup> the Comstock Fire Department received a phone call from a resident that there CO alarm ( that the department installed the alarm with the MI Prevention grant) was going off, the department responded to the home with our CO monitor. When checking the home the crew found the CO level was at 34 PPM. The normal range for CO is 9 PPM which is the acceptable daily exposure. At 35 PPM. SCBA is required. The home owner had the furnace look into and found a crack in the heat exchanger for the furnace, and the repair was made.
