
This letter is in regard to the settlement agreement and orders in the above-captioned case. Copies of the agreement and orders are attached to this letter. You will note that the settlement agreement provides that past and present board members of Learning Logics, Inc. will not "(a) apply for a license or certificate of registration for a Child Care Organization licensed or registered under the Child Care Organization Act, and (b) be connected, directly or indirectly, with a licensee or registrant, for a period of two years from the effective date of this agreement." It also provides that a former employee of Learning Logics, Inc. may be employed at other child care facilities, but only if that former employee was not also a board member of Learning Logics, Inc.

I am contacting you because you have been identified as a past or present board member of Learning Logics, Inc. I have also attached documents to this letter which verify your status as a board member. Accordingly, this letter notifies you that the settlement agreement and orders in this matter apply to you. You shall not be connected, directly or indirectly, with a licensee or registrant of a Child Care Organization for a period of two years beginning September 2, 2015.

Please be advised that violations of the settlement agreement and orders will be referred to the Department of Attorney General for appropriate legal action.

ORDER VACATING ORDER OF DISMISSAL ISSUED ON JULY 22, 2015  
AND  
ORDER TRANSMITTING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Effective April 13, 2015, all authority, powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities of the Office of Child and Adult Licensing, created in Section VII of Executive Order 2003-14, were transferred from the Department of Human Services (DHHS) to the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA), including but not limited to all of the following:

- Any authority, powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities of adult foster care, adult foster care facility, adult foster care camp, adult camp, adult foster care family home, adult foster care group home licensing and regulation under the Adult Foster Care Licensing Act, 1979 PA 218, MCL 400.701 to 400.737, the Social Welfare Act, 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.1 to 400.122, and 1974 PA 381, MCL 338.41 TO 338.47.
- Any authority, powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities of children's camp, child care center, day care center, family day care home, and group day care home licensing and regulation under 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.111 to 722.128, the Adult Foster Care Licensing Act, 1979 PA 218, MCL 400.701 to 400.737, and the Social Welfare Act, 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.1 to 400.122.

- Any authority, powers, duties, functions, and responsibilities of licensing and regulation of homes for the aged under Article 17 of the Public Health Code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20101 to 333.22260, and the Social Welfare Act, 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.1 to 400.122.


#### Executive Order 2015-4

On May 28, 2015, Respondent issued an Order of Summary Suspension and Amended Notice of Intent to Revoke Petitioner's, Learning Logics, Inc., license to operate a child care center pursuant to the Child Care Organization Act, 1973 PA 116, as amended, MCL 722.111 *et seq.* On July 21, 2015, the parties in this matter appeared and read a Stipulated Settlement into the record. On July 22, 2015, an Order of Dismissal was issued by the Michigan Administrative Hearing System (MAHS) Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) assigned to the case, inadvertently. Pursuant to Executive Order 2015-4, the Director of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs must approve the settlement agreement regarding Petitioner's license to operate a child care center pursuant to the Child Care Organization Act, 1973 PA 116, as amended, MCL 722.111 *et seq.* Therefore, the Order of Dismissal issued on July 22, 2015, by the assigned ALJ is hereby VACATED.

On September 2, 2015, the Michigan Administrative Hearing System received a written settlement agreement signed by both parties. This written settlement agreement resolves all of the allegations contained in the Order of Summary Suspension and Amended Notice of Intent to Revoke License dated May 28, 2015.

The Michigan Administrative Hearing System has removed this case from its docket, cancelled the hearing, and closed its file in this matter.

The Settlement Agreement is attached hereto, incorporated by reference into this Order, and transmitted to the Director of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs.



SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

On May 28, 2015, the Bureau of Health Care Services (BHCS) issued an Order of Summary Suspension and Amended Notice of Intent to Revoke the child care center license of Learning Logos, Inc. In settlement of all issues raised in that Order of Summary Suspension and Amended Notice of Intent to Revoke, the undersigned parties hereby agree:

- 1) Learning Logos, Inc. neither admits nor denies that the allegations set forth in the Order of Summary Suspension and Amended Notice of Intent to Revoke are true, but agrees that at least one violation of the Child Care Organizations Act, 1978 PA 116, has occurred.
- 2) Learning Logos, Inc. agrees to the revocation of its license to operate a child care center.
- 3) Learning Logos, Inc. understands that its child care center license will be revoked effective the date of the signature by the representative of the Bureau of Health Care Services.
- 4) Learning Logos, Inc. understands that it is waiving its right to appeal the Order of Summary Suspension and Amended Notice of Intent to Revoke, and an administrative hearing will not be held in this matter.

~~PAST AND PRESENT~~

- 5) Learning Logos, Inc. agrees not to (a) apply for a license or certificate of registration for a Child Care Organization licensed or registered under the Child Care Organization Act, and (b) be connected, directly or indirectly, with a licensee or registrant, for a period of two years from the effective date of this agreement. ~~THIS SHALL APPLY TO LICENSEE'S BOARD MEMBERS ALSO.~~

6) NOTHING IN THIS AGREEMENT SHALL PROHIBIT AN EMPLOYEE OF ~~LEARNING LOGOS, INC.~~ FROM BEING EMPLOYED AT ANOTHER CHILD CARE FACILITY, AS LONG AS THE EMPLOYEE IS NOT ALSO A BOARD MEMBER.
