
Dear Ms. Warner:

On June 22, 2015, the Bureau of Health Care Services, now known as the Bureau of Community and Health Systems, forwarded to you Special Investigation Report #2015D1083016, completed by Licensing Consultant Stacia Thrower. At the conclusion of Ms. Thrower's investigation you were found to be in noncompliance with licensing rule R 400.1902(3) due to household member Michael Wright's lack of good moral character and suitability to assure the welfare of children, determined by the criminal conviction history of Mr. Wright. Some of, but not all, of Michael Wright's criminal convictions include felony 2<sup>nd</sup> degree home invasion on October 6, 1998; misdemeanor breaking and entering on July 19, 1999; felony unarmed robbery on October 20, 1999; felony unarmed robbery on February 3, 2001; and, more recently, misdemeanor domestic violence on May 11, 2012.

As a result, the Bureau of Community and Health Systems is allowing you the opportunity to administratively close your family child care home certificate of registration. If, within 30 days of receipt of this certified letter, you wish to object to the administrative closure you may do so, in writing, to the address listed below. Upon receipt of your written objection, the Bureau of Community and Health Systems will proceed with a formal notice of intent to recommend revocation of your family child care home certificate of registration.
