

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

In The Matter Of:

On November 6, 2015, the Bureau of Community and Health Systems issued an *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent To Revoke* the group child care home license of Kristy Helmreich.


In settlement of all issues raised in the *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent to Revoke*, the undersigned parties hereby agree:

- 1) Kristy Helmreich does not contest the allegations set forth in Count I and Count II of the *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent To Revoke*, Bureau may treat the allegations of fact and law as true, which finding shall have the same force and effect for purposes of this settlement agreement as if evidence and argument were presented in support of the allegations.
- 2) Kristy Helmreich denies the violations cited under Count III and Count IV in the *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent to Revoke* but understands that these violations will remain a part of the licensing record and will be considered settled for purposes of resolution of the *Notice of Intent*.
- 3) Kristy Helmreich understands that her group child care home license will be revoked, effective the date of the signature by the representative of the Bureau of Community and Health Systems. Ms. Helmreich agrees to immediately cease providing care to unrelated children in their home.
- 4) Kristy Helmreich understands that under MCL 722.125, Section 15(1), a person who provides child care without a license or certificate of registration is guilty of a misdemeanor, and the offense is punishable by up to 90 days imprisonment and/or a \$1,000 fine.
- 5) Kristy Helmreich understands that she is waiving her right to appeal the *Order of Summary Suspension and Notice of Intent to Revoke* the license, and an administrative hearing will not be held in this matter.

- 6) Kristy Helmreich agrees not to apply for a license or certificate of registration for a Child Care Organization licensed or registered under the Child Care Organizations Act for a period of two years, and agrees not to be connected, directly or indirectly, with a licensee or registrant for a period of two years from the effective date of this agreement.
