SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

In the Matter of:

On May 14, 2015, the Bureau of Health Care Services issued an *Amended Notice of Intent to Revoke* the group child care home license of Araceli Perez-Suriel.

In settlement of all issues raised in that *Amended Notice of Intent to Revoke*, the undersigned parties hereby agree:

- 1) Araceli Perez-Suriel neither admits nor denies that the specific allegations set forth in the *Amended Notice of Intent to Revoke* are true, but agrees that at least one violation of the Child Care Organizations Act, 1973 PA 116, has occurred.
- 2) Araceli Perez-Suriel understands that her license will be revoked, effective the date of the signature by the representative of the Bureau of Children and Adult Licensing.
- 3) Araceli Perez-Suriel understands that she is waiving her right to appeal the *Amended Notice of Intent to Revoke*, and an administrative hearing will not be held in this matter.
- 4) Araceli Perez-Suriel agrees not to apply for a license or certificate of registration for a Child Care Organization licensed or registered under the Child Care Organization Act for a period of two years, and agrees not to be connected, directly or indirectly, with a licensee or registrant for a period of two years from the effective date of this agreement.
