Course Description:

The Michigan Fire Instructor-I program utilizes the NFPA 1041 standard for Professional Qualifications for Fire Service Instructors as its guide. All sections of this program comply with the NFPA 1041 standard for Instructor I. This is a five (5) day course. Attendance at each class session is mandatory. Each class session is eight (8) hours; a large amount of information will be missed by an absence and can't be made up. The course does include pre-course work, assignments and projects that will need to be completed outside of the classroom. Prior to the first day of class, you are required to read Chapters 1-8 in the Jones and Bartlett Fire and Emergency Services Instructor Principles and Practices, 3rd Edition. You must purchase your own book.

Min. Requirements for INSTRUCTOR I Probationary Applicant:

- Must be a member, or have been a member, within the last three years of an organized Michigan fire department
- Must possess Fire Fighter I and II certification
- Must have a minimum of three (3) years firefighting experience at the time of application and be certified at the level/course they wish to instruct.
