FINAL ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

1. On April 4, 2011, the Chief Deputy Commissioner issued an Order to Cease and Desist (hereafter "Order") pursuant to Section 251 of the Michigan Insurance Code, (hereafter "Code"), MCL 500.251, against Respondent Moss.
2. The Order contained allegations that Respondent Moss violated various sections of the Michigan Insurance Code, 1956 PA 218, as amended, MCL 500.100 *et seq.*
3. On April 4, 2011, the Order was mailed to Respondent Moss via certified mail to the Respondent's last known address.
4. On May 5, 2011, the United States Postal Service returned the Order to the Office of Financial and Insurance Regulation marked as "Unclaimed."
5. On May 19, 2011, the Order was mailed to Respondent Moss via first class mail to the Respondent's last known address.
6. The United States Postal Service returned the May 19, 2011 mailing of the Order marked as unclaimed.
7. The Order further advised Respondent Moss of the opportunity to request a hearing on the Order, as provided in Section 251 of the Code, MCL 500.251, not more than 30 days after the effective date of the Order.
8. Respondent Moss failed to request a hearing, therefore the Order is **FINAL**.
