The **Michigan Fire Instructor-II** course goal is to develop Instructor I's to have the knowledge and ability to develop individual lesson plans, learning objectives, instructional aids and evaluation instruments for a specific topic. The program utilizes the NFPA 1041 standard for Professional Qualifications for Fire Service Instructors Chapter 5 as its guide. All sections of this program comply with the NFPA 1041 standard for Instructor II. The successful completion of all portions of the program will award attendees the Fire Instructor II certification.

This is a five (5) day course. Attendance at each class session is mandatory. Each class session is eight (8) hours; a large amount of information will be missed by an absence and can't be made up. Prior to the first day of class, you are required to read Chapters 10-14 in the IFSTA, Fire and Emergency Services Instructor, 8th Edition. In addition, you must complete the study guide (Chapters 10-14) that goes with this IFSTA manual and turn it in on Day 1 for review.

Minimum Requirements for INSTRUCTOR II Applicant:

- Must be a member, or have been a member, within the last five years of an organized Michigan fire department
- Must possess Fire Fighter I and II certification
- Must be Michigan Fire Instructor I or Instructor II
- Must have a minimum of seven (7) years firefighting experience at the time of application.
- Must have 160 Hours of documented Fire & EMS Instruction
- Must attend and pass the INSTRUCTOR II course

COST: \$25 PER STUDENT

All students are required to purchase their own
