Notification of Unreliable Safety Compliance Facility Test Results

The public is advised that the Marijuana Regulatory Agency (MRA) identified inaccurate results and/or unreliable testing and reporting practices of Iron Laboratories, a safety compliance facility located in Walled Lake, Michigan. As a result, the MRA issued a <u>formal complaint</u> against – and <u>summarily suspended</u> – Iron Laboratories' facility license on August 16, 2019.

All medical marijuana products have a label affixed to the package that indicates the name and license number of the testing facility. Patients and caregivers should use caution when using products tested by Iron Laboratories (License Number SC-000003) as the test results may not be reliable.

The MRA has not been made aware of any adverse product reactions in conjunction with product tested by Iron Laboratories and is not recalling any marijuana product at this time. The MRA is continuing to investigate this matter and will issue further bulletins if appropriate.
