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The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Quimby at 9:31 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

**I. Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove that the minutes of the Commission meeting of May 14, 2019, 2019, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.**

**II.** Ms. Hamilton presented the E-Quote report for product listings in three categories (see attached report) and requested approval of the following:

That 64 new items with case size exceptions be approved for listing with an effective date of June 30, 2019, and that 2 new items with case size exception be approved for listing with an effective date of July 28, 2019; and

That 39 regular new items be approved for listing with an effective date of June 30, 2019; and that 3 regular new items be approved for listing with an effective date of July 28, 2019; and

That 16 new items with special packaging be approved for listing with an effective date of June 30, 2019; and that 1 new item with special packaging be approved for listing with an effective date of July 28, 2019.

**After discussion, the following one (1) product was denied as the Commission does not want to be the wholesaler for this product:**

750ml Toschi Nocello w/Cup&Saucer

6 Bottles/case

**Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove that the above actions be taken in accordance with the E-Quote report dated June 5, 2019, as written and presented; motion carried by unanimous vote.**

Ms. Paceagiu presented licensee requests for special price reductions on spirit products in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's Order of September 11, 2012 regarding special price reductions on spirit products, which was effective on January 1, 2013. She advised there were one hundred and five (105) different licensees requesting price reductions; that 2317 product price reductions could be approved; and that 12 product price reductions should be denied.

**Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove that the 2317 special price reductions be approved as indicated on the attached Approval for Price Reduction on Liquor reports, motion carried by unanimous vote.**

**Moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Olshove that 12 special price reductions be denied for the reason stated in the attached Notification of Denial for Price Reduction reports, motion carried by unanimous vote.**
