Significant student preparation and homework completion is required prior to the first day of class. **Prior to the start date you will need to read chapters 1-9 and complete the study guide.**

- Must be a current member, or have been a member within the last five years of an organized Michigan fire department
- Must possess a Fire Fighter I and II certification
- Must have completed a FFTD Instructor Orientation class since 2009. This course may be completed after the Instructor I program
- Must have a minimum of three (5) years firefighting experience at the time of application
