The lady called me to thank me and had said she was cooking and began to feel sleepy, very shortly after the alarm went off. We had run into her in the parking lot while doing an install and asked her if she wanted one. Good thing we did.

The other, was a lady who asked us to install one while we were next door installing alarms. She also had been cooking. Crews found high level of CO when the stove was turned on.

We installed some alarms last night in a house that had asked for CO. Got there and she had a wired monitored fire alarm system. Chief Looman and I looked and he found the system had been disabled. She was an elderly lady and thought she had a working system. She has alarms now!
