NOTICE OF TEMPORARY REGISTRATION CERTIFIED NURSE AIDE

In accordance with Executive Order No. 2020-82, Section 3, this Notice is issued to serve as the certified nurse aide temporary registration for an individual that has successfully completed a state approved nurse aide training program, regardless of whether the individual has demonstrated that they have successfully completed the examination requirements of sections 21911 and 21913 of the Public Health Code, 1978 PA 368, as amended, MCL 333.21911 and MCL 333.21913. Individual registrations will not be issued by the Department.

An employer may employ an individual as a certified nurse aide under this Notice that meets the criteria for temporary registration. This includes an individual from another state that meets the eligibility for certification through reciprocity as identified on the Department web site (www.michigan.gov/bchs / Nurse Aide Registry). An employer shall maintain a copy of this letter and a copy of the individual's successful completion of a state approved nurse aide training program or the current registration or completion of another state's training program where Michigan has acknowledged reciprocity. The employer should maintain a log of the individuals granted temporary registration with the following information: name, address, date of completion of a state-approved nurse aide training program, State in which the individual completed the program, date temporary registration began, if the individual left employment and date, the individual's date of birth (confidential), and social security number (confidential).

This temporary registration also applies to a certified nurse aide whose registration has lapsed on the Michigan Nurse Aide Registry during the state of emergency.

This Notice of Temporary Registration is issued through June 9, 2020, and may be renewed by the Department until the termination of the state of emergency under Executive Order 2020-33.
