

## **Marijuana Home Delivery Procedures**

According to the Administrative Rules, R 333.282 there are specific guidelines that must be followed in order for a licensed facility to provide home delivery services to patients.

These guidelines are very specific and cover the following:

- Patient identification and access to an online ordering system
- Patient acknowledgement of release of information for home delivery services
- Online ordering system requirements
- Home delivery employee requirements (Rule 333.281)
- Confirmation of patient identity, address, and valid patient status
- Sales documentation and daily/monthly limits
- Transport requirements – vehicle, driver, product safety and security
- Documentation requirements – transport manifest, daily logs
- Requirements regarding number of deliveries, payments, and hours of operation
- Requirement for emergency contingencies

The Bureau of Marijuana Regulation (BMR) created a procedure [checklist](#) that must be followed to assure all requirements are met, as well as a [daily log](#) to assist in capturing the required information.

Provisioning Centers that would like to provide home delivery service must develop a home delivery procedure, using the checklist to assist in creating the procedure. This procedure must be sent to [LARA-BMR-Enforcement@michigan.gov](mailto:LARA-BMR-Enforcement@michigan.gov) for review and approval. Facilities cannot begin home delivery service until their procedure is approved by BMR.
