Outstate Self-Distributor License Application

An out-of-state equivalent of various manufacturer licenses in Michigan may self-distribute alcoholic liquor that it manufactures to retailer licensees within Michigan upon being issued an Outstate Self-Distributor license pursuant to the following conditions:

- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must deliver the alcoholic liquor it manufactures to retailers in Michigan using a delivery vehicle it owns and for which an annual delivery vehicle decal has been issued.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee's own employees must deliver the alcoholic liquor it manufactures to retailers in Michigan and the employees must be individually licensed with a Salesperson license unless otherwise exempt. See the MLCC website for instructions and application information for Salesperson licenses.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must pay all applicable taxes for the alcoholic liquor it manufactures and delivers to retailers in Michigan. See the MLCC website for the applicable tax forms.

For spirits manufacturers that are the out-of-state equivalent of a Small Distiller license the following additional conditions apply for the delivery of spirits product to retailers in Michigan under an Outstate Self-Distributor license:

- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must sell the spirits to retailers in Michigan at the uniform price determined by the MLCC.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must comply with labeling and registration requirements for spirits under R 436.1829 through EQuote.
- The spirits products delivered by the Outstate Self-Distributor license must not be listed for sale to retailers in the Michigan spirits pricebook.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must not sell more than 3,000 gallons of spirits per calendar year to retailers in Michigan or the equivalent of retailers in other states.

For mixed spirit drink manufacturers that are the out-of-state equivalent of a Manufacturer of Mixed Spirit Drink license the following additional conditions apply for the delivery of mixed spirit drink product to retailers in Michigan under an Outstate Self-Distributor license:

- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must comply with labeling and registration requirements for spirits under R 436.1829 and register products through the Michigan Wholesale Product Registry (MWPR).
- The mixed spirit drink products delivered by the Outstate Self-Distributor license must conform to the bottle deposit requirements of 1976 IL 1, MCL 445.571 to 445.576, as applicable.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must submit price schedules for mixed spirit drink products pursuant to R 436.1726.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must not deliver mixed spirit drink products to a retailer located in a sales territory for which the exclusive sales rights for the mixed spirit drink products are already granted to a Wholesaler licensee.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must not sell more than 31,000 gallons of mixed spirit drink products per year of all of its brands of mixed spirit drink products combined. The 31,000 gallon threshold does not include mixed spirit drink products sold to customers at the Outstate Self-Distributor licensee's manufacturing premises.

For beer manufacturers that are the out-of-state equivalent of a Micro Brewer license the following additional conditions apply for the delivery of beer to retailers in Michigan under an Outstate Self-Distributor license:

- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must comply with labeling and registration requirements for beer under R 436.1611 and register products through the Michigan Wholesale Product Registry (MWPR).
- The beer products delivered by the Outstate Self-Distributor license must conform to the bottle deposit requirements of 1976 IL 1, MCL 445.571 to 445.576, as applicable.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must submit price schedules for beer products pursuant to MCL 436.1609b.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must not deliver beer products to a retailer located in a sales territory for which the exclusive sales rights for the beer products are already granted to a Wholesaler licensee.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must not sell more than 2,000 barrels of beer per year of all of its brands of beer products combined. The 2,000 barrel threshold does not include beer sold to customers at the Outstate Self-Distributor licensee's manufacturing premises.

For wine manufacturers that are the out-of-state equivalent of a Small Wine Maker license the following additional conditions apply for the delivery of wine to retailers in Michigan under an Outstate Self-Distributor license:

- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must comply with labeling and registration requirements for wine under R 436.1719 and register products through the Michigan Wholesale Product Registry (MWPR)..
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must submit price schedules for wine products pursuant to R 436.1726.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must not deliver wine products to a retailer located in a sales territory for which the exclusive sales rights for the wine products are already granted to a Wholesaler licensee.
- The Outstate Self-Distributor licensee must not manufacture more than 50,000 gallons of wine a year.
