Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:05 a.m. noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Southfield Appeal Hearings of October 31, 2013, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Service System Associates, Inc., 8450 W. Ten Mile, Huntington Woods, Oakland County Request ID# 702652

The licensing hearing was conducted Service System Associates, Inc., Request ID# 702652. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney John B. Carlin, Stacie Linn, General Manager and Jennifer Burrios, Assistant General Manager, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo, Mr. Carlin and Ms. Linn offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney advised this matter would be continued at a hearing scheduled for Thursday, November 14, 2013 at 10:00 A.M. at the Southfield office.

3. 408, Inc., 844 Penniman, Plymouth, Wayne County Request ID# 700162

The licensing hearing was conducted 408 Inc., Request ID# 700162. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney John B. Carlin, and James Dales, stockholder, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo, Mr. Carlin and Mr. Dales offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated September 25, 2013, and approve the request to transfer ownership of escrowed 2013 Class C license from Rock Bar & Grill, LLC as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

William Huddleston of the Brownstown Township Police Department. Mr. Asevedo, Mr. Zelenak and Sgt. Huddleston offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney advised this matter would be tabled for a hearing on a future hearing date.

5. Mt Clemens Good Times Food & Drink Inc., 140 N. Main, Mount Clemens,

Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Kelly Allen, and Brian R. Kramer, stockholder, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo, Ms. Allen and Mr. Kramer offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated October 9, 2013, and approve the request to transfer ownership of escrowed 2013 Class C license from Talmer Bank and Trust; request new Specially Designated Merchant license, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

6. F & Y, Inc., 1430 Joslyn, Pontiac, Oakland County Request ID# 709349

The show cause hearing was conducted F & Y Inc., Request ID# 709349. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Charles Frangie and Saad Fakhouri, appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Asevedo and Mr. Frangie offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the licensee has demonstrated good cause as to why he should not be suspended or revoked and that he has complied with the requirements of MCL 436.1541(1)(a)(ii), as set forth in the Show Cause Order. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:47 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
