Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:15 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Chairman Deloney, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal Hearings of August 27, 2013, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. S.Prem.S, Inc., 790 E Main, Benton Harbor, Berrien County Request ID# 672441

The licensing hearing was conducted for S.Prem.S, Inc., Request ID# 672441. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney John A. Campbell and stockholder Harvinder Singh, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Also present was Eddie Marshall, a prospective employee at the licensed business. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. Campbell, Mr. Singh and Mr. Marshall offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney advised this matter would be tabled to a hearing on a future date.

3. New Age Bay City Corporation, 510-512 E Midland, Bay City, Bay County Request ID# 701427

The licensing hearing was conducted for New Age Bay City Corporation, Request ID# 701427. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney George R. Phillips and stockholder, Gregory Kimbrue, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Also present was Peggy Kimbrue, spouse of stockholder. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. Phillips and Mr. Kimbrue offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated June 12, 2013, and to approve the request to transfer ownership of 2013 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), Dance-Entertainment Permit, Outdoor Service

(1 Area), Specific Purpose Permit (Food) and three (3) Bars from Big House Investments, Inc.; cancel existing Specific Purpose Permit (Food), as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Eau La Distillerie De Vie, 1301 S Centerville Road, Suite A, Sturgis, St Joseph County Request ID# 677135

The licensing hearing was conducted for Eau La Distillerie De Vie, Request ID# 677135. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and no one was present on behalf of the applicant. Also present were Supervisor Kurt Cox and Investigator Jon Reeder from the Grand Rapids Enforcement Division. Ms. Hetzel offered comments regarding this case and noted on the record that the applicant was properly notified of the hearing. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to affirm the previous Commission Order of denial, dated June 4, 2013, and deny the request for a new Small Distiller license, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Chairman Deloney, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 10:54 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
