## Low Impact Fire Works

Public Act 256 of 2011, the Michigan Fireworks Safety Act, requires that beginning February 1, 2012, ten days prior to the sale of any low impact fireworks such as sparklers, poppers, snakes and snaps, any persons who sell them must register. Persons are prohibited from selling low impact fireworks and must cease selling those fireworks, until they are registered on our on-line registry.

In addition, the Act requires those who sell low-impact fireworks at retail, collect the 6% Fireworks Safety Fee in addition to the 6% Michigan State Sales Tax and remit those fees to the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs. Failure to collect and remit Fireworks Safety Fees as required is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$10,000.”
