FINAL ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE

On or about on April 10, 2017, Petitioner filed with the Michigan Board of Residential Builders and Maintenance and Alteration Contractors (Board) an application for licensure to practice as a maintenance and alteration contractor in the state of Michigan with supporting documents.


On September 18, 2017, the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Bureau of Professional Licensing (Department), executed a Notice of Denial of Application for Licensure, alleging applicant did not meet one or more of the requirements for licensure pursuant to MCL 339.602(c).

The Board, having reviewed the application, supporting documents, and Petitioner's oral statement, considered this matter at a regularly scheduled meeting held in Lansing, Michigan on December 12, 2017. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Petitioner's application for licensure to practice as a maintenance and alteration contractor in the state of Michigan is DENIED.
