The Criminal Justice Training Center will be hosting the Center for Police/Fire Management and Leadership Studies Program, beginning January 8, 2020. The Center for Police/Fire Management and Leadership Studies Program is an executive-level training program designed for **law enforcement and fire service personnel** intent on earning the highest ranks in their department and those who have already achieved them. Approximately 120 contact hours will be required and divided among upper-level management topics including budgeting, labor/management issues, personnel management, legal issues, and media relations. The emphasis of the Program is on practical exercises that provide a working knowledge of the administrative function within law enforcement and fire service agencies. Presenters include MACNLOW Associates, Dolan Consulting Group, Lt. Col. Dave Grossman, U.S. Army (Ret.), and local subject matter experts.
