The meeting was called to order by Chairman Deloney at 9:33 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

I. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby that the minutes of the Commission meeting of February 12, 2019, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.

II. Ms. Hamilton presented the E-Quote report for product listings in three categories (see attached report) and requested approval of the following:

That 163 new items with case size exceptions be approved for listing with an effective date of March 1, 2019; and

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Deloney at 9:33 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

- I. **Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Chairman Deloney, that the minutes of the Commission meeting of March 12, 2019, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.**
- II. Ms. Paceagiu presented licensee requests for special price reductions on spirit products in accordance with the provisions of the Commission's Order of September 11, 2012 regarding special price reductions on spirit products, which was effective on January 1, 2013. She advised there were twenty (20) different licensees requesting price reductions; that 447 product price reductions could be approved; and that 3 product price reductions should be denied.

Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Chairman Deloney that the 447 special price reductions be approved as indicated on the attached Approval for Price Reduction on Liquor reports, motion carried by unanimous vote.

Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Chairman Deloney that 3 special price reductions be denied for the reason stated in the attached Notification of Denial for Price Reduction reports, motion carried by unanimous vote.

- III. Chairman Deloney advised we have received a request for a declaratory ruling from Attorney Joseph Infante on behalf of his eight clients – Hudsonville Winery, Inc., Nerd Craft, LLC, Allegan Lager Company, LLC, Beer Me Bro, LLC, Arbor

Brewing Company, LLC, Hop Lot Brewing Company, Harmony Brewing Company, LLC, and Saugatuck Brewing Company, Inc., respectively. The requests were received on March 12, 2019. Chairman Deloney stated the Commission, under administrative rule R 436.1973(1) has 30 days to notify the petitioner whether a declaratory ruling will be issued. A copy of the request is posted to the Commission's website.

Chairman Deloney advised that these requests for declaratory rulings are public documents and that the public is able to submit written comments to the Commission with regards to these requests. He stated that if the Commission accepts the declaratory rulings, the Commission will have 90 days from the receipt of the requests to issue a ruling. If the requests for the rulings are denied, the Commission will have 30 days from the date of denial to issue a concise written statement with the reasons for denial.
