### FINAL DETERMINATION OF DEPARTMENT

In accordance with the Michigan Medical Marihuana Act (Initiated Law 1 of 2008) and 2009 AACS, R 333.131, a petition was filed with the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs to consider adding insomnia as a qualifying disease or medical condition to the list of debilitating medical conditions under 2009 AACS, R 333.101.

After discussion and public hearing, on March 6, 2014, the Medical Marihuana Review Panel voted on a motion to add insomnia as a qualifying condition. The motion failed with a vote of 4 yes votes and 4 no votes. Pursuant to 2009 AACS, R 333.131(4), "a quorum of the review panel shall concur with the recommendation in order to be considered an official recommendation of the panel."

As a quorum of the review panel did not concur in the recommendation to approve insomnia, the petition to add insomnia to the list of debilitating conditions is denied.
