Kevin Dillon** - (Whethersfield, CT Police Department, Retired) is a 26-year veteran law enforcement officer, SWAT Commander, internationally recognized expert on combatives instructor and speaker. He is the founder and developer of the L.O.C.K.U.P.® Police Training System now presently instructed in over 18 states and five countries. He has appeared on CNN, NPR, Police Magazine.com, PoliceOne Academy Expert and Contributor for PoliceOne.com. Lt. Dillon will discuss current issues and how to use Strategies and Tactics for law enforcement and civilian personnel response to human aggression. Recent research and incidents will be discussed and how to apply the science and research to enhance tactics and response.

Lieutenant Col Dave Grossman - An internationally recognized scholar, author, soldier and speaker who is one of the world's foremost experts in the field of human aggression. As founder of a new field of scientific endeavor termed "Killology," Lieutenant Col. Grossman has made revolutionary new contributions to our understanding of killing in war, the psychological costs of war, the root causes of the current "virus" of violent crime plaguing the world and the process of healing the victims of violence, in war and in peace.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: A tag-team presentation by two internationally recognized experts that will address an integrated response for Dispatch, Police, EMS, Fire, Community members and Educators when responding to violence within the community. The key to responding to violence is to prepare strategically, emotionally and tactically. The first step is to acknowledge that violent attacks can happen to you, the second is to take steps to prevent it.

- The threat to our nation and the desperate need for an integrated response.
- Recent explosion of violence against first responders and society.
- Possibility of terrorist attacks on our soil and on our schools: A model seen around the world.
- Dispatch, first point of contact, how to extract valuable information from callers and responders alike.
- Learn methods of effective verbal de-escalation strategies for human communications, starting with telephone contact to street interaction.
- Dispatch calls such as "Swatting" and "Suicide by Cop" extraction of key information.
