DESCRIPTION: The purpose of the Fire Officer I & II course is to provide fire officers with entry and second level progression of the knowledge and skills to meet the minimum job performance requirements for paid and volunteer fire officers. Fire Officer I Candidates must demonstrate the knowledge and skills necessary to function safely and effectively as an integral member of a firefighter team while working under direct supervision of a senior company officer when engaged in hazardous activities. Fire Officer II Candidates must demonstrate the depth of knowledge and skills necessary to function under general supervision as an integral member of a team of equally or less experienced firefighters to accomplish a series of tasks.

This is a combined Fire Officer I & II program and will not be separated.
