DESCRIPTION: This course is a prerequisite to the Fire Officer I Program and is also designed for public service emergency response personnel.

This course covers a wide variety of information including the history of firefighting, fire dynamics and extinguishing agents, concepts common to all incidents including incident management systems, command and control considerations, firefighter safety, company operations, built-in fire protection, and considerations for after the incident, common concepts for specific occupancies to include, one-and two-family dwellings, multifamily dwellings, commercial occupancies, places of assembly, high-rise structures, vehicle fires and wildfires.

This course is equivalent to the Managing Company Tactical Operations-Preparing/Decision/Strategies and Tactics for Initial Company Operations series (MCTO-P, MCTO-T and STICO) and can be used as a prerequisite for the Company Officer I & II course.

(Pre-requisite for Company Officer I and II.)
