

# **Phase II Flashover & Forcible Entry**

## **PHASE II**

The Phase II system builds on the principles learned in the Phase I System. The Phase II System should be considered a working environment for the firefighters. In the Phase II System the students are now at the same level of the fire floor and take a more active roll in recognizing fire conditions. Students will utilize their hose line and nozzle patterns to check the environment, control fire gases while advancing a hose line, and ventilate fire gases through hydraulic ventilation methods.

## **FORCIBLE ENTRY**

The Oakland Fire Training Institute offers a training program in Forcible Entry that provides firefighters with a second to none realistic, hands on training experience. The Forcible Entry system, custom built by H&R Welding, is where breaching and access techniques can be enhanced and refined. It is designed for the fire fighter to utilize the same hand tools and power saws that they would use on the job. Instructors are able to have students actually breach, pry and cut through replaceable steel and wood blanks assuring the teaching points are comprehended in a cost effective manner.
