National Fire Academy Delivery National Fire Incident Reporting System Introduction to NFIRS 5.0

This is a 2-day course on how to use the standardized forms in NFIRS 5.0. This course will help fire services throughout the state to achieve uniformity in incident and activity reporting. At the local level NFIRS data can be used to:

- Describe a community's fire problem,
- Support budget requests,
- Improve decision making for allocation of resources,
- Assist in planning for future protection,
- Identify opportunities for scheduling nonemergency activities,
- Evaluate code enforcement programs; and identify target audiences for public fire education programs.
