Online MFFTC Instructor Orientation

This 3-4 hour course covers the structure and services of the Bureau of Fire Services, Fire Fighter Training Division, Michigan Fire Fighters Training Council, instructor levels and requirements, instructor application process, and instructional policies and procedures.

This course is a required pre-requisite to becoming a certified fire service instructor in Michigan and needed before you can apply for probationary instructor status. Individuals who have taken the Instructor I course (H07B) will need to have this course prior to submitting their probationary instructor application.

Individuals applying for Instructor I reciprocity through their Michigan EMS IC license or valid Michigan Department of Education Teaching Certificate will need this course prior to submitting their probationary instructor application.
