<ul> <li>(ii) The supervising individual's name and license or registration number and the state in which the supervising individual is licensed or registered as a professional engineer.</li> <li>(iii) Documentation from the supervising individual attesting to the work experience, dates of work, and supervision.</li> <li>(3) Engineering work that satisfies all of the following requirements qualifies as professional experience: <ul> <li>(a) The work involves the use of engineering principles and data.</li> <li>(b) The work is in the form of consultation, investigation, evaluation, planning, design, or review of materials or completed phases of work in the construction, alteration, or repair in connection with a public o private utility, structure, building, machine, equipment, process, work, or project.</li> <li>(c) The work is performed while under the direction of a professional engineer licensed in Michigan or licensed or registered in another state.</li> <li>(4) The department shall grant not more than 5 years of professional experience credit to an applicant holding a degree that satisfies the requirements under R 339.16021. Credit shall be limited to the following amounts:</li> <li>(a) Not more than 4 years of professional experience for a baccalaureate degree in engineering. Experience shall be granted for only 1 baccalaureate degree.</li> <li>(b) Not more than 1 year of professional experience for a post-baccalaureate degree in engineering.
