**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

November 23, 2020

9:00 a.m.

The public hearing will be held virtually via Zoom to receive public comments while complying with statutorily required measures designed to help prevent the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID 19).

The hearing is held to receive public comments on the following administrative rules:

**Athletic Trainers – General Rules (MOAHR #2020-16 LR)**

**Authority:** MCL 333.16145, 333.16148, 333.16178, 333.16186, 333.16204, 333.16205, 333.16215, 333.16287, 333.17904, and 333.17905 and Executive Reorganization Order Nos. 1991-9, 1996-2, 2003-1, and 2011-4, MCL 338.3501, 445.2001, 445.2011, and 445.2030.

**Overview:** The proposed rules will add a definition of emergency cardiac care; add a telehealth rule; remove the requirements of first aid, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and automated external defibrillator training and add emergency cardiac care training for licensure, relicensure, and renewal; identify approved providers for emergency cardiac care training; remove the minimum English language rule; and clarify continuing education rules.

**Nursing Home Administrators – General Rules (MOAHR #2019-140 LR)**

**Authority:** MCL 333.16145, 333.16148, 333.16178, 333.16287, and 333.17309 and Executive Reorganization Order Nos. 1991-9, 1996-2, 2003-1, and 2011-4, MCL 338.3501, 445.2001, 445.2011, and 445.2030.

**Overview:** The proposed rules will add a telehealth rule; update accreditation standards; remove the minimum English language standard; clarify the requirements for relicensure and licensure by endorsement; and clarify rules pertaining to continuing education.

**Real Estate Appraisers – General Rules (MOAHR #2019-114 LR)**

**Authority:** MCL 339.205, 339.308, 339.2605, and Executive Reorganization Order No. 1991-9, 1996-2, 2003-1, and 2011-4, MCL 338.3501, MCL 445.2001, MCL 445.2011, and MCL 445.2030

**Overview:** The proposed rules will update the exemptions from the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP) by exempting board members and investigators from Standard 4 reporting; reduce the use of a temporary permit by nonresident appraisers in circumstances where a full license is appropriate; provide for a program to allow a supervisory appraiser to supervise more than 3 trainee appraisers and clarify the requirements for a supervisory appraiser; update the requirements pertaining to review of prelicensure educational

courses and continuing education programs; and allow licensees to submit attendance at a Michigan Board of Real Estate Appraisers meeting for continuing education credit.

### **Respiratory Care – General Rules (MOAHR #2020-17 LR)**

**Authority:** MCL 333.16145, 333.16148, 333.16174, 333.16287, and 333.18709, and Executive Reorganization Order Nos. 1991-9, 1996-2, 2003-1, and 2011-4, MCL 338.3501, 445.2001, 445.2011, and 445.2030.

**Overview:** The proposed rules will add a telehealth rule; remove the working knowledge of the English language rule; clarify the requirements for licensure by endorsement; update accreditation standards; and clarify relicensure requirements.

The rules will take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State, unless specified otherwise in the rules. Comments on the proposed rules may be presented in person at the public hearing. **Written comments will also be accepted from date of publication until 5:00 p.m. on November 23, 2020, at the following address or e-mail address:**
