The following provides a brief review of the changes that have occurred since your last update:

- MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL CODE
  - (HB-5798) P.A. 353 OF 2014, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 17, 2014.
    - Corrected a typographical error in Sections 105 and 405.
  - (SB-271) PA 47 OF 2015, EFFECTIVE JUNE 9, 2015
    - Amends (MCL 436.1101 - 436.2303) by adding sec. 1014.
      - The new law:
        - Prohibits an on-premises licensee from advertising, selling, or offering to sell, two or more identical drinks containing alcoholic liquor to an individual for the individual's consumption for one price.
        - Allows an on-premises licensee to advertise, sell, or offer to sell, an unlimited quantity of alcoholic liquor at a specific price if it is in connection with a private function.
          - Defines a "private function."
- MICHIGAN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
  - CHURCH OR SCHOOL HEARINGS
    - Revised R 436.1953 by correcting an incorrect code citation of Section 107(5) to correctly reflect Section 107(7) – published in 2015 MR 11.
    - Revised R 436.1959 by correcting an incorrect code citation of Section 107(5) to correctly reflect Section 107(7) – published in 2015 MR 6.

  - Updated to reflect the newly adopted section of the Code.
