Enclosed is the April 2016 quarterly update of the Michigan Liquor Control Code, Administrative Rules, and Related Laws. These new pages should be used to replace the corresponding pages of your Codebook. As the revised Book Order/Subscription Service form in the front of the Codebook indicates, quarterly updates are sent to all subscribers in January, April, July, and October of each year, providing changes have occurred during the quarter. The last quarterly update sent to subscribers was June 2015.

The following provides a brief summary of the changes made to the Code since the last update:

- Book Order/Subscription Service form (following the Codebook *Forward* section)  
This form was revised to better describe the subscription process, define the term *quarterly update*, and create a space subscriber's email address. It also includes a statement that all quarterly updates and fully updated codebooks are always available at <http://www.michigan.gov/lcc> in the *Commission Documents Library* under the *MLCC Code, Administrative Rules & Related Laws* and under *Publication Updates*.
- The Table of Contents section (at the front of the Codebook)  
This entire section is revised to reflect the changes made during this quarterly update.
- The Youth Employment Standards Act (Excerpts) (Pages 15 to 22.2)  
This entire section is revised to reflect various statutory changes, as well as revised History and Compiler's Notes.
- Amended MCL 436.1205 (pages 32, 32.1, 33, and 34)  
These pages reflect changes made to Michigan Liquor Control Code of 1998 per 2015 PA 246 (HB 4581), effective March 21, 2016, which increased the maximum fee paid to vendors of spirits to offset the costs incurred in contracting with an authorized distribution agent from \$7.50 to \$8.25.
- Amended MLC 436.1531, (Section 7 (Pages 78-83.1))  
Includes changes made in 2014 pertaining to the issuance of a Tavern or Class C license without regard to the quota for a professional international soccer match.
- Added MCL 436.1914a (pages 110 and 110.1)  
These pages reflect changes made to Michigan Liquor Control Code of 1998 per 2015 PA 165 (SB 240), effective January 26, 2016, which prohibits using possessing, or selling powdered alcohol.
- Added or amended the following Sections of the Michigan Vehicle Code:

MCL 257.7b, MCL 257.33, MCL 257.518a, MCL 257.624a, MCL 257.625p, MCL 257.657, MCL 257.660, MCL 257.662, MCL 257.901, and MCL 257.907 (pages 153 to 158.6).

These pages reflect a number of statutory changes per 2015 PA 126 (SB 165) and 2015 PA 127 (SB 166), which provided the requirements under which commercial quadricycles operate and may allow passengers to transport open or uncapped alcoholic liquor unless prohibited by local ordinance.

- Rescinded Rule 436.1311 (page 186)

This page reflects the rescinding of Rule 436.1311 of the Michigan Administrative Code under Section 44 of the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969, MLC 24.244, which provides for the rescission of a rule that is obsolete or superseded (Prohibited depiction of minors on alcoholic liquor labels or advertising).

Updated information to Rule 436.1951 through Rule 436.1963 (pages 226 and 227)

These pages reflect the addition of and/or changes made to the History and Complier's Notes for the Rules pertaining to *Church or School Hearings* of the Michigan Liquor Control Code of 1998.

- Updated Codebook Index

These pages reflect changes to the *Index to Liquor Control Code, Related Acts and Administrative Rules of the Commission* that pertain to changes made to the Codebook during this quarterly update.
