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## **Notification of Inaccurate Potency Results**

The Marijuana Regulatory Agency (MRA) is issuing this advisory due to inaccurate potency results entered into the statewide monitoring system from The Spott – a licensed safety compliance facility located in Kalamazoo – for the time period beginning May 3, 2019 and ending July 11, 2019.

The THC results printed on the label may not be accurate; the results listed on the label may be higher or lower than the actual dose. All medical marijuana products have a label affixed to the container that indicates the date of testing and the testing facility.

Patients and caregivers should reference the date and testing facility on the label and should use caution when ingesting the marijuana-infused products mentioned in this bulletin, as they may be stronger than labeled.

The MRA has worked closely with The Spott to identify products that were affected and to add additional quality control parameters to ensure that this problem does not occur in the future.
