The special workgroup meeting will begin at 10 a.m., but members of the public may access the meeting 5 minutes before it begins.

Any decisions made prior to the disconnection will be binding. The Board will not recess or adjourn due to technical or other issues experienced by individual members of the public that render them unable to attend or participate in the meeting.
