

# FAA Part 107 Prep for UAV – Q19B

The course provides the basic knowledge to establish a firm foundation for a career as a professional commercial sUAS pilot. This is accomplished by the familiarization with regulations (14 CFR Part 107), airspace classification, operating requirements, and flight restrictions, aviation weather sources and effects of weather on sUAS, sUAS loading, emergency procedures, crew resource management, radio communication procedures, performance of sUAS, physiological effects of drugs and alcohol, aeronautical decision making and judgment, airport operations, and maintenance and preflight inspection procedures. Successful passage of FAA Remote Pilot UAS rating certificate should place students in a positive position for employment in the commercial sUAS field upon graduation.
