



## Sticky Spider Web

Create a sticky spider web with tape and have your little superhero try to catch some "bad guys" in the web, just like a real one would catch a fly.

### What you need:

- Tape (works best with heavy duty tape, like painters tape)
- Paper

### What you do:

- Find a doorway in the house that you can use for this project
- In the top half of the door, use tape to create a spider web design. This can be done by stretching a piece of tape from one side of the door frame to the other in all different directions so the tape overlaps in different spots. The web can be as large as you would like.
- Find paper and crinkle each piece into a ball (the kids will have fun helping with this step! Old newspaper works great.)
- Have the child throw the paper balls at the spider web to see how many they can get stuck!

If you would like, read a Spider Man book to go with this activity to count toward your summer reading goal!
