DOCKET ASSIGNMENT PROCEDURES

Docket Numbers are assigned to each petition and consist of three parts:

1. A two digit number at the beginning of the sequence represents the calendar year during which the petition was filed with the Commission.
2. The letter(s) in the middle of the sequence represent the type of petition.
 - AP** annexation petition by property owner(s), authorized agent, or registered voters in the territory proposed for annexation;
 - AR** annexation petition by city resolution.
 - I** incorporation of a city or village;
 - C** consolidation of municipalities;
3. The one or two digits at the end of the sequence represent the amount of filings for a certain type of petition during the specified calendar year.

EXAMPLES:

Docket #06-AP-9 represents the ninth annexation petition filed by a property owner, authorized agent or registered voters during the 2006 calendar year;

Docket #06-AR-3 represents the third annexation petition filed by city resolution during the 2006 calendar year;

Docket #06-I-3 represents the third incorporation petition filed during the 2006 calendar year; and,

Docket #06-C-1 represents the first consolidation petition filed during the 2006 calendar year.
