On March 27, 2018, the Elevator Safety Board reviewed the General Motors Technical Center variance request for relief from the requirements of Sections 8.6.8.15.7 and 6.1.6.3.8 of the 2010 edition of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) A17.1 Safety Code for Elevators and Escalators adopted by the 2010 edition of the Michigan Elevator Rules. This final decision is ordered pursuant to Section 8(1)(c) of 1967 PA 227.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS: The Board acknowledged receipt and reviewed the material on this matter at the meeting on the above noted date. Mr. Chris Gallagher, thyssenkrupp Elevator Corporation, attended the meeting and provided testimony to the Board.
