Dear Mr. Cannon:

On May 7, 2015, Roeiah Epps, licensing consultant for the Bureau of Health Care Services (BHCS), concluded Special Investigation #2014A0986030 and recommended the revocation of your adult foster care family home license. BHCS's Disciplinary Action Unit (DAU) presently holds that recommendation.

After a review of the file, BHCS determined the following: (1) your license to operate Abundant Life expired on April 1, 2015, and (2) you had not submitted a renewal application. Pursuant to 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.291(2), a license expires if the licensee does not submit a timely and sufficient renewal application prior to the expiration date. Therefore, by notice of this letter, BHCS is administratively closing your license.

Please be aware that should you apply for an adult foster care license in the future, you will need to address the findings of Special Investigation #2014A0986030.
