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## Final Plat Exact Copies and Original Prints

Recent changes at the private reproduction companies the Department has been using to create exact copies of final plats as required by MCL 560.171(a) and R560.104(3) necessitated our looking for alternative sources to fulfill the Department's responsibilities.

We have made arrangements to procure the final plat exact copies through the MDOT Engineering Print group at their cost of \$1.68 per sheet printed. Our Department incurs a cost of \$55.00 per plat to procure the exact copies, i.e., delivery/pick-up time, mileage, etc. Thus, the exact copy fee is calculated as follows:

- No. of sheets in plat x No. of copies = No. of sheets printed
- No. of sheets printed x MDOT copy cost per sheet = Total MDOT Copy Cost
- Total MDOT Copy Cost + OLSR Cost = Total Copy Fee

The exact copy fee will need to be provided when the final plat is submitted for review. **Please review** the Plat Review Request forms available on our website, as they contain updated information pertinent to the exact copy costs and process. **NOTE:** Page 1 of the Plat Review Request form must accompany all checks for a plat review or exact copy fees.

The surveyor or proprietor submitting the final plat for review is responsible for obtaining the original prints required under MCL 560.132(b) and in accordance with the material and print processes outlined in R560.104(2). Other than the two processes identified in R560.104(2)(a) and (b), radiant fusing that does not use a fuser oil and certain latex printing process are acceptable. If, however, your printer is unsure if their equipment meets the necessary standards required, please have them submit the manufacturer's specifications and a test plot to the Office of Land Survey for review.

The Department is not responsible for identifying reproduction companies that can accommodate these needs nor does the Department maintain a list of reproduction companies. The Office of Land Survey does maintain a list of acceptable printers/plotters.

Currently the following printers/plotters are acceptable:
