

Directions

From I-96 - From Lansing

Take I-96 to M-6 (westbound) EXIT 24, towards Holland. Take M-6 to M-37 Broadmoor Avenue, EXIT 15. Turn right on Broadmoor Avenue for approximately two miles. Between 52nd Street and 44th Street, merge to the left lane. Watch for sign directing to Barden Street. Make a U-turn, and merge to the right lane. Turn right at traffic light (Barden Street). Turn left at the Lacks Enterprises driveway (at flag poles).

From I-96 - From Muskegon and Big Rapids

Take I-96 to South M-44 / M-37 E. Beltline Avenue EXIT 38, towards Holland. Turn right and follow M-37 South for 22 miles. After 44th street, proceed to the next traffic light (Barden Street) and turn right. Turn left at Lacks Enterprises driveway (at flag poles).

From US-131 - Kalamazoo

Take US-131 to M-6 (eastbound) EXIT 77, towards Lansing. Take M-6 TO M-37 Broadmoor Avenue (EXIT 15) towards Grand Rapids. Turn left on M-37 Broadmoor Avenue for approximately two miles. Between 52nd Street and 44th Street, merge to the left lane and watch for sign for Barden Street. Make a U-turn, and merge to the right lane. Turn right at traffic light (Barden Street). Turn left at Lacks Enterprises driveway (at flag poles).
