- MTMIC will promote MIOSHA's Consultation, Education and Training (CET) services to their policyholders, which include companies in high hazard industries that are included in MIOSHA's Strategic Plan.
- MTMIC's loss control department will participate in and promote the MIOSHA Training Institute (MTI) and promote MIOSHA's alliance program activities.
- MTMIC and MIOSHA CET will jointly develop industry/hazard specific Fact Sheets that will be shared on MIOSHA's website.

Training and Education:

- Encourage members to participate in CET safety and health hazard surveys and consultation with applicable training for management and hourly employees as needed.
